THE TIMELINE - HISTORY OF JAMNABAI NARSEE SCHOOL



THE TIME LINE :

Jamnabai Narsee School has developed a rich history in the field of education in its relatively young life.

Founded in 1971 by the Narsee Monjee Educational Trust, staffed by a dedicated team of teacher-facilitators, the school in its fifth decade has established itself as a model of academic excellence and co-curricular cultural experience for all its students.

The school motto 'Vidya Param Balam' - Knowledge is Strength Supreme - has indeed proven to be the guiding vision statement and the beacon light for all.

Jamnabai Narsee School is a secular co-educational private minority school managed by the public charitable trust that was established by Sarvashree Chatrabhuj Narsee, Shri Pratap Narsee and Shri Dharamshi Narsee in December 1970. Today, while providing a positive learning environment to our students, the school prepares the students of the secondary school for two curricular options :

The Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (ICSE) examinations - CISCE, New Delhi. At the higher

secondary school level the following is offered :

Indian School Certificate (ISC) Examinations - CISCE - New Delhi. Having completed Pre-Primary schooling, students have the option of continuing at JNS or undertaking the PYP at JNIS.

Upon completion of Std. 5, students can either continue at JNS or undertake the MYP at JNIS.

After Std. 7, students may choose to prepare themselves for the ICSE examinations through JNS or pursue the IGCSE curriculum at JNIS.

Post ICSE, a higher secondary student may wish to undertake the ISC course (JNS) or the IBDP at JNIS.

The comfort of the parent and student with this integral K-12 system that has been provided by the school for 5 decades of growth, assures the community around of a well balanced educational approach, unmatched in the city of Mumbai.

THE ORIGINS :

On January 17, 1971, Jamnabai Narsee Multipurpose Higher Secondary School was inaugurated

by the Narsee Monjee family. Sarvashree Chatrabhuj Narsee, Shri Pratap Narsee and Shri Dharamshi Narsee decided to start an English medium school to provide broad based education at all stages from K-12. The new Trust so formed was to look after the development and the management of this institution.

Plans for a traditional type of school building were completed. But when the Trustees were convinced that a structure with clusters of hexagonal classrooms was more functional, they willingly accepted the new plans.

In January 1971, the school started functioning under the leadership of the founder Principal, Shri Soli Pavri. There were 440 students with 30 teachers. At present the school is proud to cater to almost 5000 students with 350 teachers.

Ours was the first school in the city to provide Gujarati and Marathi as second languages for the ICSE Examinations.

Ours was the first school in the city to provide for hobbies as part of the school day programme, that hone talent/skills and provide opportunities for further development.



Ours was the first school that had the best cricket team of the MSSA in a short span of 10 years since the school's inception.

Ours was the first school that started the three level teaching approach that catered to the gifted, the average and the students with special needs in each academic subject. Hobbies still continue and remedial teaching is provided for the differently abled students.

The Board of Trustees believe that education is a creative process where the efforts of the child, the parent and the educator unite to create a personality which will face the unknown future with humility, confidence and joy. Excellence in education is possible only because of a disciplined management approach within an environment of delegation, trust and control when needed. Co-ordination of well tested policies by the Board of Trustees has helped to evolve Jamnabai Narsee School into an institution of integrity, offering quality education.



THE WHEELS :

The JNS Parent Teacher Association (PTA) was founded on the Vijaya Dashami Day in October 1979. Since then the parental body has greatly cooperated in all the cultural and co-curricular activities of the school and set a benchmark for all the PTAs of newly founded institutions in Mumbai.

The Jamnabai Narsee Alumni Association (JNAA) was established in 1983 with the objective of 'keeping in touch' with the Alma Mater. Over a period of time, this body has truly kept the JNS Alumni bonded all over the world.

As the years roll by, JNS has only one constant - 'CHANGE'.

PRESCHOOL



At Jamnabai Narsee Preschool, we believe that children need motion, novelty, adventure and to engage themselves with the world.

Jamnabai Narsee Preschool provides children with opportunities to broaden and deepen their essential skills which will prepare them for a life of learning and empower them to make positive contributions to the world around them. The Preschool teachers believe in the methodology in which they purposefully engage with students in direct experiences and focused reflection to increase knowledge and develop skills through discovery and exploration. The little enthusiastic learners expand their curiosity and creativity through an integrated approach following the eight pedagogies of teaching by Howard Gardner, Maria Montessori, Friedrich Froebel, Loris Malaguzzi, Rudolf Steiner, Rabindranath

Tagore, Dr. Mariale Hardiman and the Early Years Programme. They are adapted in a well-balanced manner, facilitating holistic development.

The curriculum is designed to facilitate the optimum development of a child's full potential. Books and worksheets are specially customised and designed by the teachers to lay the foundation of all-round development. Field trips act as a tremendously refreshing activity that break the monotony of the classroom. Visits to the beach and park present practical knowledge to students.

On completing the Preschool years, parents have the choice to opt for the Primary schooling at JNS (affiliated to the CISCE Board) or the Primary Years Programme (PYP) affiliated to the International Baccalaureate (IB) at JNIS.



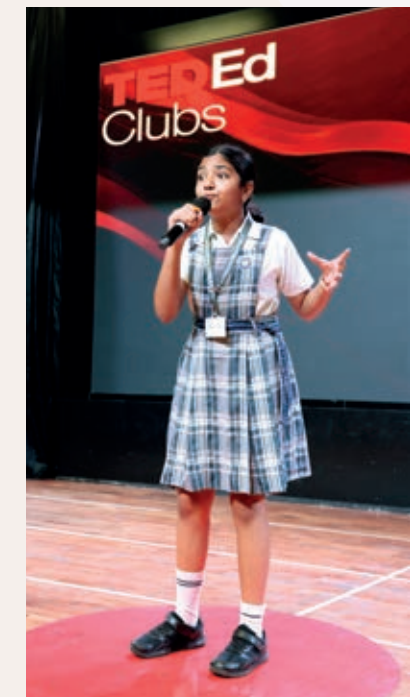

PRIMARY SCHOOL

ICSE INDIAN CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION EXAMINATION



In the Primary Section, learning comes alive through meaningful experiences and joyful exploration. Rooted in an experiential approach, our teaching goes beyond textbooks, enabling children to learn by doing, observing, and reflecting. Our curriculum is thoughtfully designed to nurture curiosity, creativity, and critical thinking through problem-solving tasks, project-based learning, collaborative activities, and inquiry-driven exploration. Every child is encour-

aged to ask questions, express ideas, and discover their unique potential in a supportive environment. We believe that education extends beyond the classroom. Regular field trips to nature parks, conservation centres, and eco-friendly destinations help children develop a deep respect for the environment and an understanding of the world around them. A rich blend of art, craft, music, dance, yoga, and physical education forms an integral part of our programme, ensuring holistic

development of mind and body. Through these, children build confidence, discipline, and self-expression. In the Primary Section, focus is not merely on competition, but on cooperation, empathy, and character-building. We strive to create a happy and inclusive learning space where every child feels valued, inspired, and eager to learn.

The Middle School (Std. 6 to 8) and Secondary School (Std. 9 and 10) are transitional channels of intellectual curiosity. At this stage, an interdisciplinary approach is adopted by presenting content in a synthesised fashion. A concentric curriculum ensures that a child is presented with age-appropriate information at every stage. In order to enable students to fit into a global world, an international dimension is incorporated through collaborative learning.

Educational excursions, nature trails, exploration camps, and participation in co-curricular activities make the education programme a stimulating learning experience for all. Value Education fits into the curriculum designed and offers a holistic approach. Graded learning provides experiences to pupils in proportion to their strengths, needs and interests.

In Std. 8, 9 and 10, students are given the opportunity to contest

for elections in the Student Council. They partake in Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), the Jamnabai Adolescent Mentor (JAM) Programme - a peer counselling initiative and EUMIND (Europe Meets India) - a cultural exchange programme. An aptitude test is conducted in Std. 8, 9 and 10 to guide students through their subject selection and stream selection respectively.



ISC INDIAN SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION



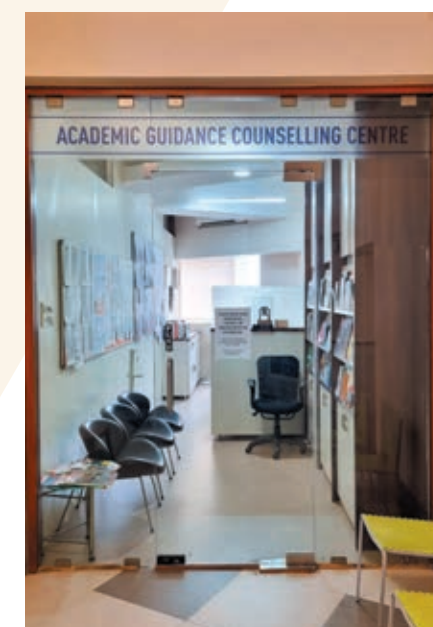
The ISC curriculum aims at stimulating the intellectual, physical, spiritual and emotional faculties of children. The pupils of Std. 11 and 12 prepare for the Indian School Certificate Examination conducted by the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations, New Delhi. A comprehensive programme of two years of ISC can be pursued in any one of three streams, namely- Humanities, Commerce and Science.

The ISC provides myriad opportunities to explore, grow and shine through debates, dramatics, art, sports and fashion designing.

The Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW) programme, the Annual World Summit - a United Nations simulation, the EUMIND cultural exchange programme, TedEd Club, TED-style talks, the CO-OP Programme - an internship programme that aims to integrate

students' academic achievement with relevant, quality work experience, the Student Council and the Jamnabai Adolescent Mentor (JAM) programme - a peer mentoring programme that equips students with skills to become future leaders.

AGC THE ACADEMIC GUIDANCE COUNSELLING CENTRE



The Academic Guidance Counselling Centre helps students navigate their future course of study from Std. 8 onwards and organises career events to explore various career opportunities.

Jamnabai Narsee School has partnered with Cialfo, a platform that integrates information and supports students through the application process, with the aim to provide complete information on their best-fit courses.

The School offers Mindler Assessment, a platform that helps student make informed decisions by providing assessments and resources.

It is a matter of great pride that the scholastic and co-scholastic achievements of our students have consistently received recognition from universities in the USA, Canada, Singapore, Dubai, Australia the UK and European nations, in the form of merit scholarships.

Jamnabai Narsee School is also licensed to administer the SAT and PSAT.

NURTURE HOUSE & RESOURCE ROOM



At Nurture House, we provide counselling services to the students and parents of the school. Our work includes individual counselling of students with various concerns ranging from anxiety to mood issues, emotional regulation, peer interactions, assessments of learning needs and facilitating the remedial needs of students with special needs. A team of psychologists conduct value education classes throughout the school on various relevant subjects based on the emotional and developmental needs of the students.

Age-appropriate and periodic interventions are carried out to help students introspect and find ways to navigate various challenges of life. Health talks conducted by experts to enable students to adjust to their growing bodies and the emotional changes that accompany adolescence. The Jamnabai Adolescent Mentor Programme is a leadership role for students from Std. 9 and 11 who apply, interview and are trained to offer peer support for

a term of two years. A special off campus leadership training is conducted for the Student Council and Jamnabai Adolescent Mentors to equip them with the relevant skills to meet the various challenges of being entrusted with responsibility.

Remedial programmes are offered to students from Std. 1 to 8 who have difficulties grasping lessons in a classroom. They are provided with different educational strategies like more practise, clarification, repetition of content and individual attention to deliver the content to the student. Remedial teachers deploy requisite teaching activities and strategies to ensure the students perform to their full potential by overcoming any learning barriers and where the foundational education concepts are consolidated for the child.

Founded in 2015, Jamnabai Narsee International School (JNIS) is a leading international school offering the International Baccalaureate (IB) and Cambridge International curricula from Grades 1 to 12. We combine academic excellence with collaboration, communication, creativity and international-mindedness, preparing students to succeed in an interconnected world.

Guided by the motto *Preparing Minds for a Changing World*, JNIS empowers students with the knowledge, skills, values and adaptability needed to thrive in a rapidly evolving global society. Our mission is to help every learner realise their full potential and grow into confident, compassionate and responsible global citizens. Through a holistic approach to education, we foster intellectual curiosity, wellbeing, leadership and a lifelong love of learning. Our state-of-the-art campus provides outstanding facilities for academics, the arts, sports and technology, enabling every child to flourish.

JNIS is an authorised IB World School offering the complete IB continuum, comprising the Primary Years Programme (Grades 1-5), the Middle

Years Programme (Grades 6-10) and the Diploma Programme (Grades 11-12). To provide greater flexibility and choice, students in Grades 8-10 may also opt for the Cambridge IGCSE Programme, ensuring internationally recognised pathways that support their individual strengths, interests and future ambitions.

Primary Years Programme (Grades 1-5)

The PYP places the child at the centre of learning through inquiry, curiosity and action. Students develop conceptual understanding across trans-disciplinary Units of Inquiry while strengthening research, thinking, communication, self-management and social skills. The programme culminates in the Grade 5 PYP Exhibition, where students investigate real-world issues and present meaningful solutions.

Middle Years Programme (Grades 6-10)

The MYP encourages students to connect classroom learning with the real world through concept-driven, inquiry-based education. It develops critical thinking, creativity, reflection and intercultural understanding. Students demonstrate their learning through eAssessments, ePortfolios and the Personal Project, showcasing their passions, skills and independent learning.

Cambridge IGCSE Programme (Grades 8-10)

The Cambridge IGCSE Programme offers a rigorous, internationally recognised curriculum that promotes analytical thinking and academic depth. Students undertake Cam-

bridge Checkpoint Assessments in Grade 8 before progressing to IGCSE examinations in Grades 9 and 10 across a broad range of subjects.

Diploma Programme (Grades 11-12)

Following the MYP or IGCSE, students may pursue either the **IB Diploma Programme (IBDP)** or the **Indian School Certificate (ISC)** curriculum.

The IBDP is a globally respected pre-university qualification that develops knowledgeable, principled and caring young adults. Alongside rigorous academics, its Core components—Theory of Knowledge (TOK), the Extended Essay (EE) and Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS)—cultivate research skills, ethical thinking, intellectual independence and a commitment to service. Sporting, cultural and leadership opportunities further enrich students' learning and prepare them for success at leading universities and beyond.

Beyond the Classroom

Learning at JNIS extends beyond academics. Through meaningful service-learning experiences, students engage with local and global issues, developing empathy, leadership, sustainability and social responsibility. These experiences empower them to become confident changemakers who contribute positively to their communities.

Guided by the values of integrity, humility, respect and service, JNIS nurtures reflective, resilient and responsible global citizens, equipped to make a meaningful difference in an ever-changing world.

On 10th January, 2013, Shri Narendra Modi gifted a land area of 1.6 acres to the Narsee Monjee Educational Trust and entrusted it with the responsibility of establishing Jamnabai Narsee School in GIFT City, Gandhinagar. The school was inaugurated on 14th May, 2015 by Hon. Minister of Education and Women's welfare, Gujarat - Smt. Vasuben Trivedi.

Gujarat International Finance Tec (GIFT) City envisions development of a global financial hub for international financial services which will serve as a paradigm for Next Class Development in terms of quality of life, infrastructure and ambience, utilizing land as a precious resource. Jamnabai Narsee School, GIFT

City, is the first school in the First Smart City of India, as well as the first school in the State of Gujarat to receive the Green Building Gold Certification. Consistently ranked as the premier school in the twin cities of Ahmedabad & Gandhinagar.

A K-12 School affiliated to the CISCE, Jamnabai Narsee School offers an integrated curriculum with a rich blend of academic and co-curricular activities. It boasts of world class infrastructure which includes an Auditorium, Convention Centre, Health Care Unit, Cultural Activity rooms, indoor and outdoor Sports Activity Centres, Science and Computer Laboratories, Cafeteria, 70 classrooms, faculty rooms and school bus facility.

The school provides intensive learning that is devoted to service, developing a positive attitude, inculcating empathy for others and preservation of traditional wisdom for the development of conscientious responsible global citizens. The mission is to help students 'Excel in all areas of Endeavour' and become self-reliant, principled and balanced individuals.

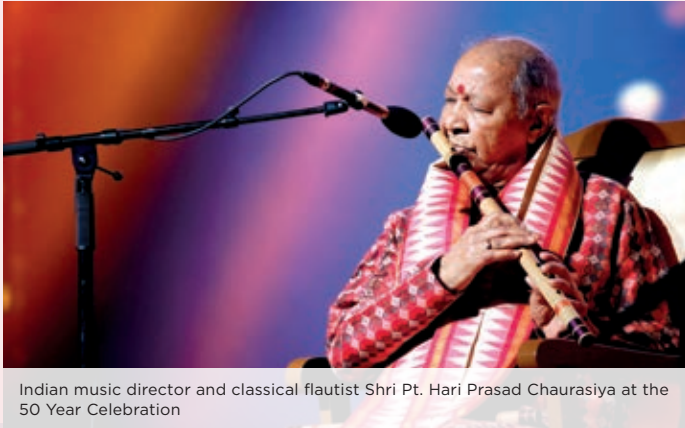
