## **THE INDIAN SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (ISC)**

**The Council for the Indian School Certificate Examinations** was established in 1958 by the University of Cambridge Local Examinations Syndicate with the assistance of the Inter-State Board for Anglo-Indian Education. It is registered under the Societies Registration Act No. XXI of 1860.

The Council conducts the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education and the Indian School Certificate Examinations.

The Indian School Certificate Examination has been designed as an examination, through the medium of English, in accordance with the recommendations of the New Education Policy 1986, after a two-year course of studies beyond the Indian Certificate of Secondary Education (Year-10) Examination or its equivalent.

## AN ICONIC INSTITUTE OF LEARNING



Founded in 1971, Jamnabai Narsee School stands as a powerful edifice of academic excellence and outstanding contribution in the field of sports, art and concern for the community. Situated in the western suburbs of Mumbai, Jamnabai Narsee School provides child-centred teaching and learning processes from the pre-school years through to the Indian School Certificate Examination (ISC). Jamnabai Narsee International School is authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organisation to offer the Primary Years Programme (Grades 1 to 5), Middle Years programme (Grades 6 to 10) and Diploma Programme to students of Grades 11 and 12. The school also offers

Cambridge - International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) programme to students of Grades 8 to 10. Integral to the academic programme of the school are the philosophical bases of Indian education where the 'GURU' (teacher) lights the divine lamp of wisdom in his/her 'Shishya' (student) and allows learning to ignite the mind. Global empathy and a willingness to encompass cultural diversity in a pluralistic society are the strengths inculcated in students. The School's motto is 'Knowledge is strength supreme' and the guiding principle is 'Let learning be a joy, and teaching, a pleasure.'

## THE ISC PROGRAMME

The ISC is an intellectually stimulating and challenging curriculum. The curriculum provides students with value-based and quality teaching-learning experiences, relevant to future vocational and professional requirements as well as university academic programmes.

Service, a core component of the ISC curriculum is aimed at making positive changes in society. As a part of the Socially Useful Productive Work (SUPW), the ISC students of JNS have taken up the 'Each One Teach One' programme where they interact with students of rural schools.

The Jamnabai Narsee Adolescent Mentor (JAM) Programme conducted by the Counselling Cell of the school offers interested students the opportunity to be trained as peer counsellors for the school. The training benefits the individual as well as provides an opportunity to serve the student community at Jamnabai Narsee School.



In an endeavour to create global citizens, Jamnabai Narsee School encourages students to develop a global perspective through various international programmes like International Award for Young People (IAYP), Harvard Model Congress (HMC), Design for Change, EUMIND (Europe meets India, an Exchange Programme) and Harvard Model United Nations (HMUN).

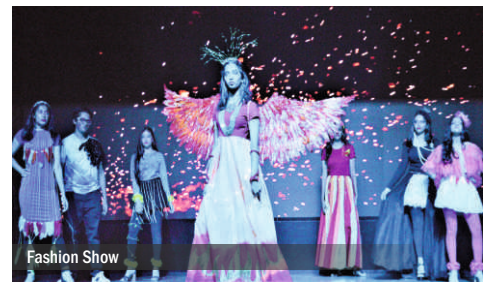

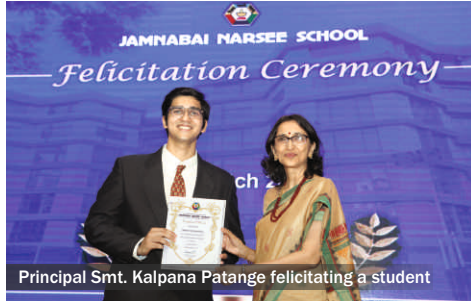

# Jamnabai Narsee Co-Op Programme – 'Experience the real world'

Jamnabai Narsee School is consistently ranked among the top schools nationally on diverse parameters that contribute to academic excellence coupled with the holistic development of children. In keeping with the spirit of nurturing our students into well-rounded individuals equipped to face the demands of a dynamic world, Trustee, Shri Sujay Jairaj, introduced an internship programme to help our students discover their passions, hone their skill-sets and gain valuable experience that furthers their growth as individuals.

Thus, was born the Jamnabai Narsee Co-operative Education (CO-OP Programme), an annual month long internship programme for the students of ISC Grade 11 that seeks to integrate students' academic achievement with quality work experience.



For the second consecutive year, our students were placed with a wide array of firms across sectors such as law, banking, fashion designing, data science, bioresearch, therapy and medicine.

Prior to the placement, students were given guidance on how to design crisp and impactful résumés and were provided with soft-skills training to help them ace their first exposure to professional interviews.



The students interned either virtually or in-person with their respective firms for a month from 17 March to 17 April, 2022 and the internship itself was an enriching experience for students as they worked to upgrade their knowledge and enhance their competencies by gaining relevant experience in sectors aligned with their interests. It helped broaden their horizons while giving them their first hand exposure to the rigorous demands of the competitive world of work.



Echoing the sentiment of gratitude felt by the student body, Arnav Shah, who interned with ICICI Bank as part of the programme, said, "I am glad I received this opportunity as it has not only deepened my knowledge of data science but also given me the exposure of working in a large organization."



## ACADEMIC GUIDANCE COUNSELLING



The Academic Guidance Counselling Centre guides students through major decisions pertaining to their future course of study based on their desired career goals. Comprehensive guidance is provided to help students select majors in line with their strengths, inclinations and career aspirations. The centre also supports students through every step of the university application process.

In addition to providing comprehensive guidance for further education, the centre organizes an annual Career Fair to orient students of classes IX to XII to the wide array of career options available for them to explore. The centre also organizes visits from Indian as well as foreign colleges and universities.



### SAT CENTRE

Jamnabai Narsee School is one amongst the select group of educational institutions that are licensed to administer the SAT.

SAT is a computer-based test taken by the students of Grades XI and XII. SAT scores are accepted as an admission tool by prestigious foreign universities, particularly those in the USA. Certain universities in India too, now evaluate SAT scores.

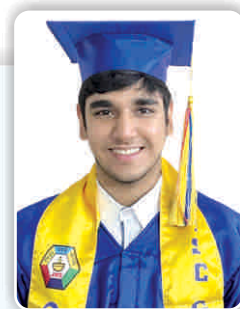

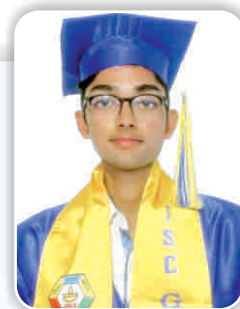
